

Guidelines for Community Service

Volunteer & Make the World a Better Place!

- 1. Volunteering is your opportunity to give back to your community, and help to make a positive impact on the lives of others. Volunteer activities are also important in demonstrating to colleges that you are a mature, well-rounded, involved, and caring citizen.
- 2. The hours served must be for the benefit of the community and not for the benefit of a profit making business.
- 3. You may not count your membership in a religious organization, such as a youth group or choir as community service. If you perform community service with such a group, the hours do count. Performing religious duties does not count, but helping with office work or maintenance at a religious institution counts.
- 4. Membership in Scouts or Explorers does not count towards community service hours. If you perform volunteer work as part of your scouting activities, you may count them.
- 5. Volunteering to work on a political campaign or to register voters counts as community service.
- 6. If your participate in an after-school or weekend service project at West Adams Preparatory High School, it counts as Community Service as long as it is not a class or a club assignment for a grade. Working in the cafeteria or an office, or tutoring at lunch or after school counts (if it is during class time it does not count). Helping a teacher with his/her duties during school time, such as grading papers, does not count.
- 7. Contributing blood during a blood drive counts as (2) hours.
- 8. Babysitting is not a community service. Day care is usually a business, not a non-profit organization, unless it is HEAD START of LAUSD Childcare Center, or other non-profit organizations, and you are not being paid.
- 9. Volunteering at any hospital or free clinic counts, but volunteering at a private doctors office does not.
